Information for students

Before lessons start, it is necessary:

- to ensure that your login and password for [CAS](#) are valid, (for more information on [CAS](#) see <https://ldap1.cuni.cz/language/switch?lang=en>),
- to have your **e-mail** entered and validated on [CAS](#) <https://ldap1.cuni.cz/account/validate/nomenu/1>, with the time zone (in your e-mail) set to UTC+1 (Brussels time),
- to be enrolled in e-learning course [GM First Aid](#) <https://moodle.lf1.cuni.cz/course/view.php?id=1006>, the enrolment key is **GM_fa_23**
- to have access to [MS Teams](#) and [Outlook](#), both available from <https://www.office.com/> (login and password are the same as for CAS or SIS) with the time zone (in your account) set to UTC+1 (Brussels time).

Skills training sessions

Skills training sessions are organized according to the regular schedule (*see below*) as **face-to-face sessions** in skills labs (*see instruction below*). Face-to-face sessions are provided for small groups of students and the number of seats per session is limited. Registration is therefore required. The list of training dates is given in LMS Moodle, the student chooses one of them and attends only once every two weeks to each lesson. Each group enrolls for its set date and time, in case of emergency the student can choose another date and/or time if it is available. Students are expected to arrive at least 10 minutes before the start of each session (*face-to-face, as well as on-line session*). Activity during sessions, as well as timely attendance, are graded. Students are required to bring their student ID (*ISIC card*) to each session, attendance will be recorded.

Face-to-face sessions

Information on venue for **face-to-face sessions** is provided below.

Basic infection control measures during skills training sessions include:

- 1) hand hygiene,
- 2) the use of non-sterile gloves, other measures can be added as needed.

Other details including **dress code** are specified in **SIS**.

Skills training sessions are usually held on **Mondays** except e.g., bank holidays (*see detailed schedule on SIS*). The irregular sessions are listed below.

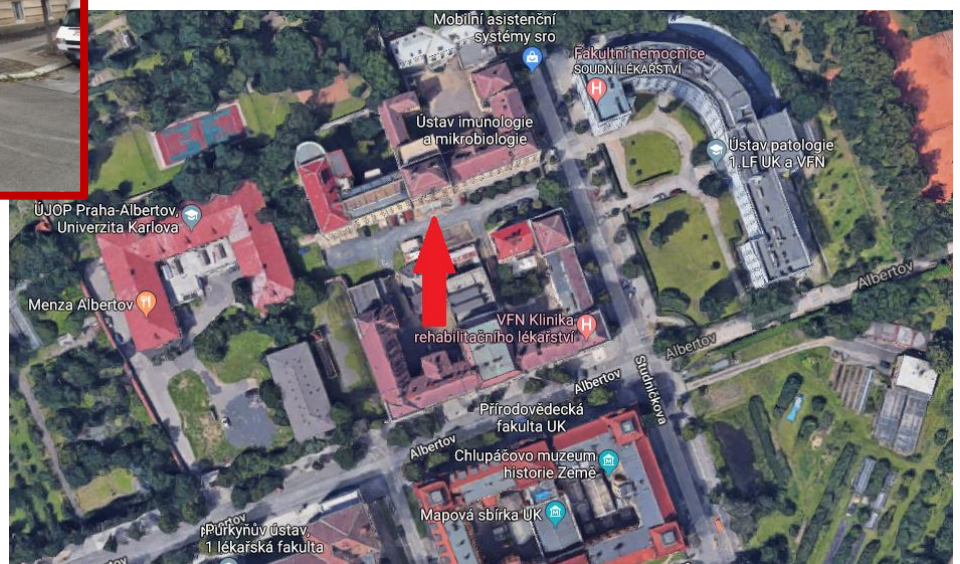
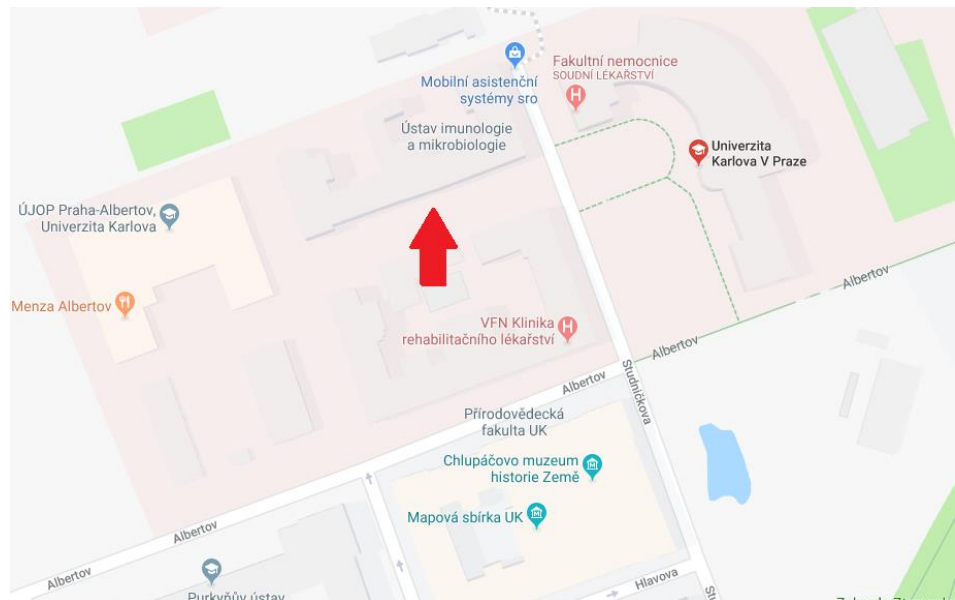
