Teaching in 2nd Department of Internal Medicine – the rules for students

Academic year 2023/2024, winter semester

Teaching period: 2. 10. 2023 - 12. 1. 2024 Examination period: 15. 1. 2024 - 18. 2. 2024 Christmas vacation: 23. 12. 2023 - 1. 1. 2024

Lectures:

1/ The lectures will be given in most cases in person (if not, the students will be informed in time and will have the presentation available in MOODLE).

2/ The lectures may be recorded in MS Teams. Thereafter, the recorded lesson will be available in MS Teams for 14 days and the students may download it to MOODLE.

However, recording the lectures as well as downloading to MOODLE is the responsibility of the students, not the lecturers.

3/ The lecture will be given if attended by at least a minimal number of students (i.e. ≥ 3 students). Otherwise, the lecture may be cancelled.

Practical classes

You should have a white coat, slippers, a sthetoscope and a visible ID card. Wearing a face mask is recommended.

The practical classes should focus on communication with the patients, history taking, complete physical examination, ECG interpretation and a brief introduction to the use of laboratory and imaging methods in internal medicine.

The credit will be given provided the presence in the minimum of 10 classes, 9 practical classes (in the period 2nd October to 22nd December) and a practical exam (in the period 2nd to 12th January), respectively.

The practical exam will be performed in the time of practical classes in the last two weeks of semester and the students will be (if possible) examined by the teacher of the parallel group. The practical exam will consist of history (or part of the history) taking and physical examination of a part of the body or, eventually, an ECG description (according to the examiner's instructions).

The substitution of a practical class is possible only in agreement with the teacher/teachers and the student must ask them in advance.
